**T**o insure an adequate supply of clean water at all times for all uses, lawn water restrictions will begin June 1st. *(See details at right)*

*This policy only applies to lawn watering. Other water usage, including watering of vegetable and flower gardens, is not restricted.*

**P**ermits for limited daily watering of new lawns are available at the BMU office.

# 2011 Lawn Watering Policy

From June 1 through September 30

- Customers with odd-numbered addresses (ending with a 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9) may water lawns on Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.
- Customers with even-numbered addresses (ending with 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8) may water lawns on Sunday, Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Violators subject to fine of up to \$200 per day.

### Water Rate Information:

**The regular water rate for city residents is \$1.787 per 100 cubic feet (748 gallons).**

Water usage during the winter (December-March) is averaged for each customer, as well as for all residential customers.

During the July, August, and September billing periods, customers can use up to three times (300%) their individual winter average, or the city's residential winter average (whichever is higher) and still pay the regular rate.

Water usage that exceeds three times (300%) the individual or city winter average (whichever is greater) will be billed at double the regular rate.
